Set your clocks back one hour before you go to bed on Saturday, November 6, for the ending of Daylight Savings Time. We get an extra hour of sleep, praise God!

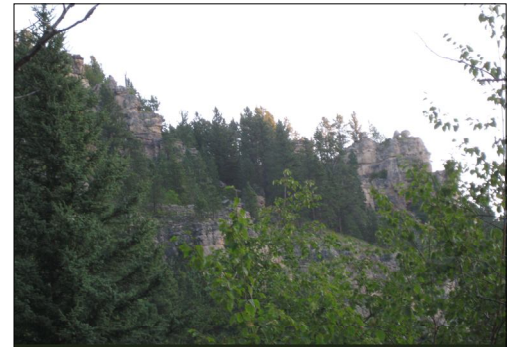
CELL GROUPS UP AND RUNNING!
